PLATE 5: VAGRANT SEABIRDS

1 CORY'S SHEARWATER Calonectris diomedea 45–56 cm; WS 100–125 cm P r/f 1a C. d. diomedea (Scopoli's Shearwater) Slightly smaller than borealis (Plate 2:5), with slimmer bill, rather paler head and mantle. Underwing patterns: 1b C. d. borealis Primaries wholly dark, creating solid, well defined, broad black band on outer wing and rounded white underwing panel. 1c C. d. diomedea White wedges on inner webs of otherwise black outer primaries, resulting in narrower black band on outer wing and more angled white underwing panel. ▲ Non-breeding visitor, Mauritania—Gulf of Guinea.

1d Cape Verde Shearwater C. edwardsii Underwing pattern as 1b.

- NORTHERN FULMAR Fulmarus glacialis

 43–52 cm; WS 101–117 cm V

 Stocky; head and underparts typically white; upperparts pale grey. Flies on stiff, straight wings.

 ▶ Palearctic vagrant, offshore Senegal.
- 3 ATLANTIC YELLOW-NOSED ALBATROSS Thallasarche chlororhynchos 71-81 cm; WS 178-205 cm V EN 3a Ad Underwing white with narrow black border; head pale grey; bill black with orange-yellow culmen and pinkish-orange tip. 3b Juv Head white; bill all black. ▲ Potential vagrant from Southern Ocean. See 4.
- 4 BLACK-BROWED ALBATROSS Thallasarche melanophris

80-95 cm; WS 213-246 cm V EN 4a Ad from below Underwing white with broad black band on leading edge; small dark 'brow'; bill orange-yellow. 4b Ad from above Dark 'saddle' and upperwings; white rump; grey tail. 4c Juv Underwing largely dark, with only ill-defined whitish stripe along centre. Bill greyish-brown with blackish tip. A Vagrant from Southern Ocean. Albatross seen offshore Congo (Aug 1988) was presumably this species or 3.

- 5 SOUTHERN GIANT PETREL Macronectes giganteus 86-99 cm; WS 185-210 cm V VU Very large (like small albatross). Massive, pale bill. 5a Ad dark morph Greyish-brown with whitish head. 5b Ad white morph All white with some black specks. Flight laboured, stiff wingbeats interspersed with short glides. ▲ Vagrant/rare visitor from Southern Ocean, offshore Congo.
- 6 CAPE CORMORANT Phalacrocorax capensis
 61–64 cm; WS 109 cm V NT
 6a Ad breeding Medium-sized; black; yellow-orange gular area. 6b Ad non-breeding/imm
 Dull brown, underparts paler; yellowish-brown gular area. ▲ Vagrant from southern African
 coasts, north to Gabon. ♣ [CD5:3a]
- JACKASS (AFRICAN) PENGUIN Spheniscus demersus c. 60 cm V VU Stocky, flightless seabird, with flipper-like wings, and short legs and tail. 7a Ad Black face and throat surrounded by white; black band across breast down flanks. 7b Juv Sooty-grey head and upperparts. ▲ S African vagrant, Gabon and Congo. Floats with head held high and most of body submerged. On land, walks upright with waddling gait.
- BALEARIC SHEARWATER Puffinus mauretanicus 30–40 cm; WS 76–93 cm V CR 8a-b Resembles Manx Shearwater (Plate 2:10), but brownish above; dirty greyish-buff below; dark axillaries and vent. ▲ Vagrant from W Mediterranean, recorded off Mauritania. ❖ [CD1: 5a]
- 9 BLACK-BELLIED STORM-PETREL Fregetta tropica 20 cm; WS 46 cm V 9a-b White rump; white belly with black stripe on centre; white underwing-coverts. ▲ Vagrant from Southern Ocean, Gulf of Guinea. Claimed off Liberia and Sierra Leone. ❖ [CD5:1b]
- WHITE-BELLIED STORM-PETREL Fregetta grallaria 20 cm; WS 46 cm V? Similar to 9; belly all white; underwing with more white, dark leading edge narrower. ▲ Potential vagrant (single record north of Cape Verde).



